

POOL PARTIES

Tremont HOA encourages fun and the use of our amenities to the fullest extent, and we've implemented a procedure for requesting pool parties simply to keep things safe and to keep the pool from being overcrowded.

To use the pool for a pool party, residents will need to do the following:

A) At least two weeks prior to the requested pool party date, send an email to contact@tremontcommunity.com to get approval to host a pool party at the pool. The email must contain the following information pertaining to your pool party:

B) Once the HOA reviews your request, you will receive an approval/disapproval notice via email.

C) If you are approved, the notice will indicate whether or not you will be required to retain the lifeguard beyond their scheduled working hours. (this will be dependent on the logistics of your party-- date, time, number of guests/swimmers, if there's another function going on at the pool that day, etc)

D) A \$25 deposit must be paid in advance of the party and will be returned to you after the event once it is deemed that you have cleaned up satisfactorily. You must clean up after your event is over – Litter and debris resulting from the party must be placed in trash bags (provided by you), tied, and taken to the trash cans in the car park.

**You cannot request a pool party on a holiday or a holiday weekend.
